The Birnbergs gutted and redesigned it to be a tea shop on the first level and a small flat for the baker and her husband on the second. It was the first of the Smallsea "Village" buildings. The "Village" part of the Smallsea Museum was the "working people" and old town part of the city. With this building every effort was made to achieve a worn, aged look.
