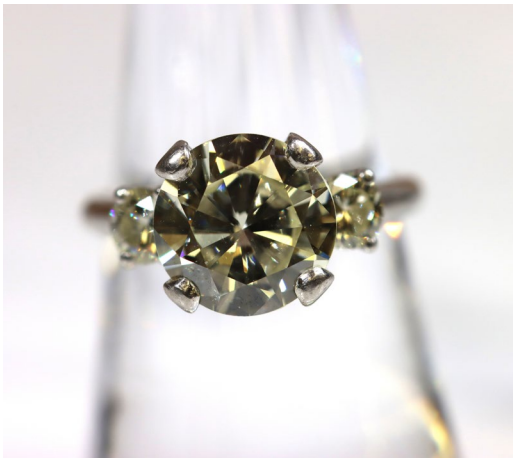

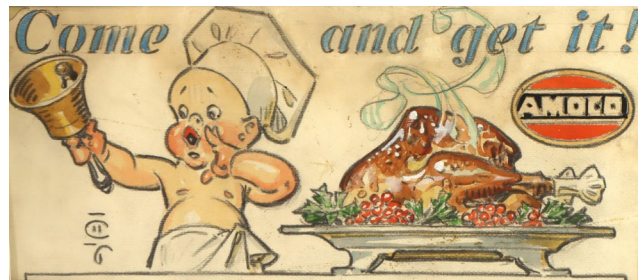

Joseph Christian Leyendecker (March 23, 1874 – July 25, 1951) was a German-American illustrator, considered one of the preeminent American illustrators of the early 20th century. He is mostly known for his work for the Saturday Evening Post, and is credited for inventing the modern magazine design after producing 400 magazine covers, 322 for the Saturday Evening Post. Featured in this fine art auction is the piece *Don't let General MacArthur down – buy war bonds!* by Leyendecker - a study of General MacArthur painted in 1943 oil on canvas. The final piece he painted named *General MacArthur*, in similar fashion, sold for \$109,000. MacArthur was a well-known U.S. general who commanded the Southwest Pacific Theatre in World War II and guided operations in Korea. J. C. also painted recruitment posters for the United States military and the war effort are widely known around the world including the Saturday Evening Post war babies.

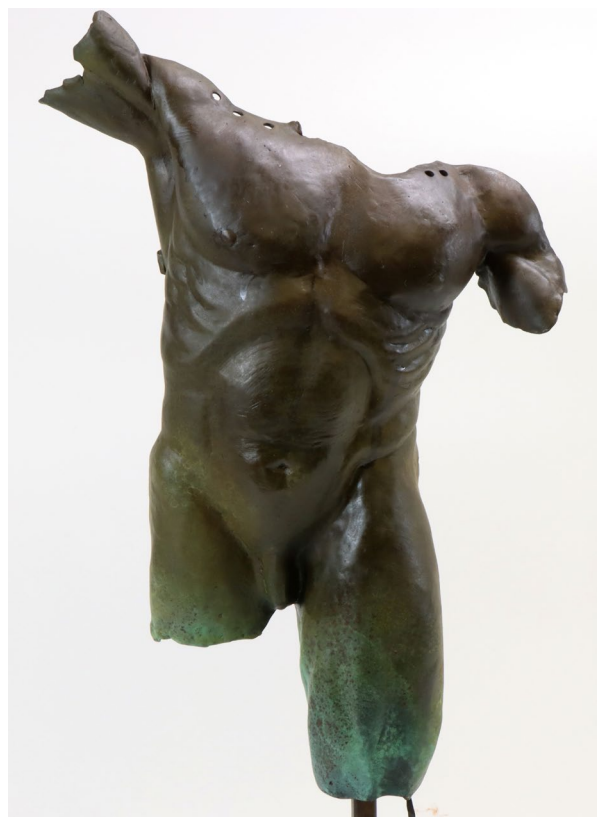




Single Owner Collection
