INFORMATION REGARDING THE REAL ESTATE SELLER DISCLOSURE LAW

 - 8. Transfers of a property to be demolished or converted to non-residential use.
 - 9. Transfers of unimproved real property.
 - 10. Transfers of new construction that has never been occupied and:
 - a. The buyer has received a one-year warranty covering the construction;
 - b. The building has been inspected for compliance with the applicable building code or, if none, a nationally recognized model building code; and
 - c. A certificate of occupancy or a certificate of code compliance has been issued for the dwelling.

COMMON LAW DUTY TO DISCLOSE

Although the provisions of the Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law exclude some transfers from the requirement of completing a disclosure statement, the Law does not excuse the seller's common law duty to disclose any known material defect(s) of the Property in order to avoid fraud, misrepresentation or deceit in the transaction. This duty continues until the date of settlement.
