Aqua Guard Waterproofing Contractors, Inc., herein referred to as Aqua Guard Basement Systems, or contractor, proposes to provide such services to owner/agent. Contractor will furnish all necessary labor, materials, machinery, insurance and other requirements to perform such services indicated by this contract. Any alteration or deviation from above specifications involving extra costs will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate. All agreements contingent upon strikes, accidents or delays beyond our control. Owner to carry fire and other necessary insurance. All proposals based primarily on homeowners description of problem. Some dust should be expected from work.

Owner/Agent Responsibilities: Owner/agent to provide access to work by removing any obstructions and personal items. Contractor not responsible for damage to items in work area. Owner/agent to provide at their expense water and electricity and must turn off HVAC while job is in progress to minimize dust. Contractor assumes no liability for damage to underground or under floor pipes, drain lines, irrigation lines, wiring, tanks, utility and/or service lines, or other non usable installation unless notified by owner/agent in writing prior to start of work. When excavation is involved, contractor is not responsible for any finish landscaping, plant life, or wash out due to heavy rains after completed work. Contractor may offer option to remove dry wall, paneling, flooring or any wall covering for a stated fee, however, because of factors beyond of our control, (such as rotten wood, corroded or rusted connections, screws, bolts, oversized nails, poor design or sub standard construction, etc.) contractor accepts no responsibility for the usefulness or appearance of any items removed. Any subsequent work, repairs, remodeling or replacement shall be at owner/agent's expense unless otherwise stated. Owner/agent to provide electrical outlet for sump pump, dehumidifier or any installations requiring power. Contractor not licensed to perform electrical services.

Service Guarantee: All services provided and purchased under this contract are guaranteed to satisfy the intended purposes in those areas where applied and specified by the contract for a period of _____ years (see written warranty). This service guarantee applies only to walls/areas serviced under this contract. Should leakage occur from any walls/areas not covered by the guarantee, a free estimate for additional waterproofing will be furnished upon request. Standard manufacturer's warranty only on mechanical devices (sump pumps, valves, dehumidifiers, etc.) No warranty is expressed or implied covering dampness, condensation or concrete discoloration of walls and/or floors treated by contractor. Guarantee on installed system does not cover backing up or plugging of sewer lines, floods, or drain lines not installed by contractor. In the event service is required in areas previously waterproofed or mechanically installed, the contractor sole liability shall be to repair the leakage/problem and is not liable for any damage to the building or personal property that resulted due to the water leakage, or water removal.

Cost of Service: All services provided and purchased under this contract shall be done in a workmanlike manner in accordance with standard practices for the sum of \$_____. A deposit in the amount of \$_____ is required upon confirmation of the work to be done. Balance due of \$_____ will be due and shall be paid to the foreman on the day of completion. Warranties will become effective when balance is paid in full. Should sub grade rock, substandard construction according to standard building codes, hidden defects, monolithic slab not detected during estimate, slabs in excess of 6", or any other unforeseen circumstances be encountered preventing the orderly completion of service outlined in this contract the owner/agent and contractor agree to re-negotiate this contract without prejudice. This fee typically represents, but is not limited to 10% of the original contract price. Interest charges will accrue at the rate of 1 1/2% per month (18% annually) on any balance after date of completion. Should any legal actions be required to collect any moneys due under this contract, purchaser agrees to pay all court costs and reasonable attorney's fees. This contract contains the full agreement between the parties and no representation made by any agent shall be binding unless specifically incorporated herein.

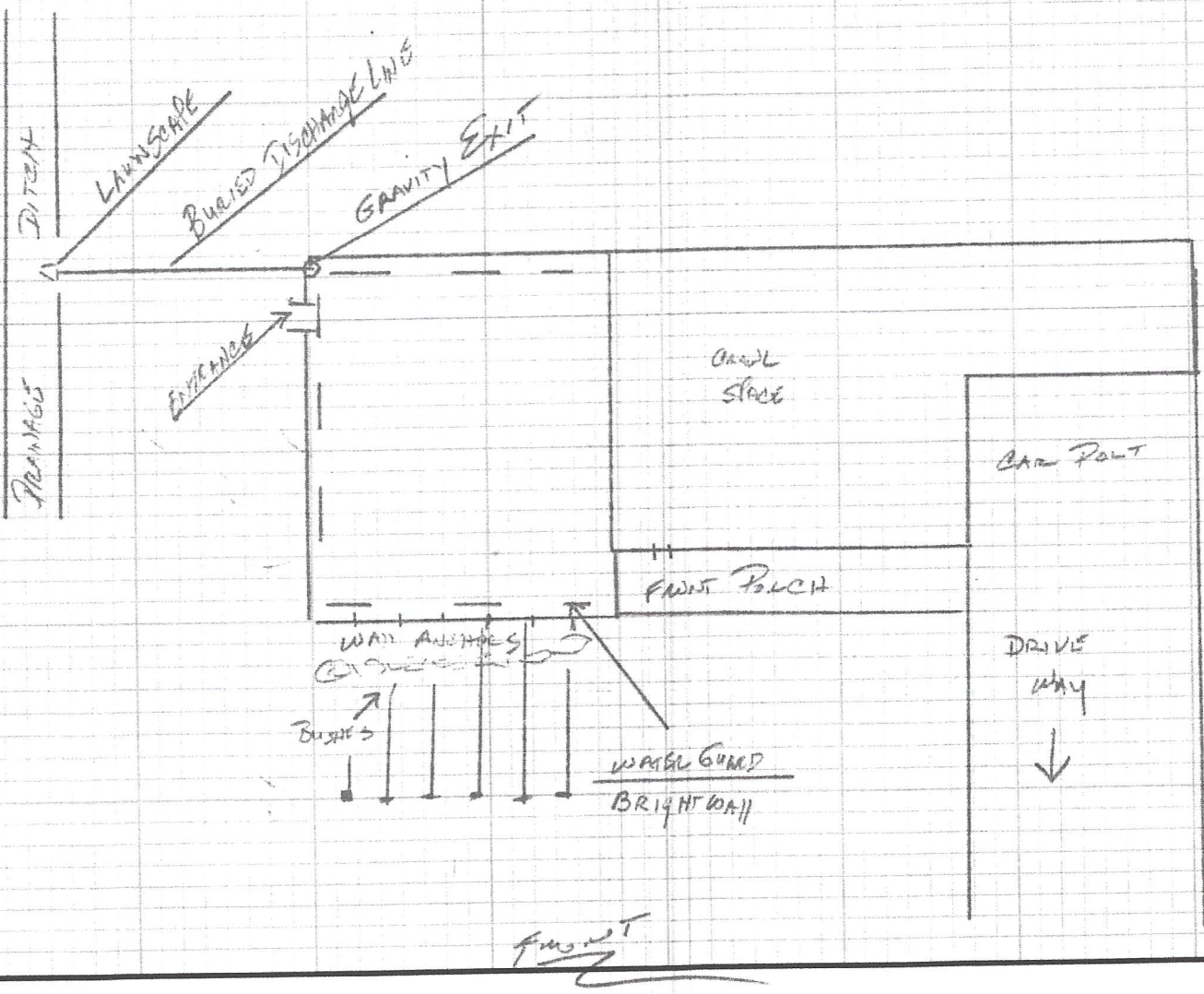

WARRANTY

AquaGuard Basement Systems hereby warrants

The Basement Water Control System installed at: 2734 Regal Way Tucker Georgia 30084

To be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service and that no water shall pass from any wall where the system has been installed, through the system and collect on the basement floor; said warranty shall be in effect for the lifetime of the structure from the date of completion of installation. This warranty may be transferred to future homeowners with written notification to AquaGuard Basement Systems within 45 days before the closing date of acquisition of the property. An inspection of the work installed must be completed insuring the system is working properly and as designed. A Fee of \$95.00 shall be charged and the warranty will be transferred to the new homeowner.

Type of System installed: Interior Subfloor Waterguard System

The warranty contained herein shall not apply to condensation or any system which has been repaired by a party other than the contractor or has been altered in any way or which has been subjected to misuse, negligence or accident. Contractor's liability under this warranty shall be limited to the replacement within the aforesaid time of any defective work or material, and contractors shall be liable for no other damages or losses. Pump and/or mechanical components are under separate manufacturer's warranty and are not considered as part of the water control "no leak" warranty. Contractor is not responsible for frozen discharge lines, water once pumped from the house, vapor transmission, discoloration from capillary action, water squirting out of walls over the system, if a higher volume pump is required, dust incidental to system installation, fuel tanks or lines or alarm service. Contractor of course can only be responsible for areas of the basement specifically treated by the work performed. Homeowner agrees to keep gutters clean, and run a dehumidifier in basement in summer (to control condensation).

This warranty is made in lieu of all other warranties expressed or implied and of all other obligations or liabilities on contractor's part.
