THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this

1968, by and between GERALD P. SCHOENFELDER, hereinafter referred to as FIRST PARTY, his heirs, personal representatives and assigns, and ROBERT A. BROWN, GLEN A. TIBBITTS, and DICK H. YOUNG, Trustees of the Waterloo Water Works of the City of Waterloo, lowa, hereinafter referred to as SECOND PARTY, their successor Trustees and assigns;

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid by Second Party to First Party, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the covenants and agreements herein contained, First Party hereby grants and conveys to Second Party an easement for the purposes herein set forth over the following described property of the First Party, to wit:

A strip of land 30.00 feet in even width lying in the NE Fractional 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of Section 2-88-13, Waterloo, Black Hank County, lowa, said 30.00 feet being measured normally outward from a closed parcel of land described as follows:

The Southwesterly right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 218 is assumed to bear N. 35° 20° W. and said Southwesterly right-of-way line intersects the East line of said Section 2-88-13 at a point 799.77 feet North of the Southeast corner of the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 2-88-13.

The easement is granted for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining, repairing or replacing a water main or mains of such size or sizes as the Second Pr., may determine from time to time to meet the needs and requirements of the Second Party, and for the flow of water through the same with the right of temporary ingress and egress over such additional adjacent property of the First Party as is necessary to reach said main or mains for the purpose of exercising the rights granted under this easement. A copy of a survey of the above described easement course and the premises to be served thereby prepared by Robert E.

Schenk and certified under date of June 28, 1968 is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof.

It is further agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. In exercising its rights under the aforesaid easement, the Second Party shall have the right, if necessary, to temporarily pile any dirt excavated on adjacent land of the First Party.
- 2. Second Party agrees to replace or remove any dirt excavated and place any portion of the First Party's premises used by the Second Party, including a reseeding of the same, so as to place said property in substantially the same condition as existed prior to any use thereof by the Second Party and shall maintain the surface of the premises over which this easement is granted in substantially the same condition as existed prior to any use thereof.

- 3. The First Party reserves and is given the right to use the land over which this easement is granted in any manner which does not interfere with the easement and use granted to the Second Party.
- 4. Second Party shall lay its water main or mains in the outer 10 feet of the 30 foot easement course hereinabous described and the outer 10 feet of said easement course shall be reserved for the installations of Second Party.
- 5. The easement granted herein shall continue as long as the easement is used for the purposes herein granted.
- 6. The easement herein granted is part of a general utility easement to be granted in the future to all public and private corporations and agencies as may have occasion to serve, service or supply said property with water, sanitary sewers, gas, electricity or communication services, and said Second Party shall make use of its easement in such a manner as not to interfere with the use of said property for this future easement.

Any easement hereinafter granted to others for sanitary sewers, gas, electric or other communication services, shall contain a provision that the easement or easements so granted shall not interfere with the use of said property by the second property as provided herein, and that all present and existing laws of the State of lowar, or ordinances of the City of Waterloo, lowar, shall be complied with by the grantee of such easement with respect to the location of any installations in proximity to the main or mains installed by second party.

7. Attached hereto marked Exhibit "B" and by this reference made a part hereof, is a cross-section which shows the location of the various utilities within the general utility easement. First Party agrees to attach Exhibit "B" to all other easement agreements entered into with such entity as will supply sanirary sewers, gas, electric or communication services.






