

DEDICATION OF RIGHT OF WAY FOR PUBLIC ROAD PURPOSES

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, that the Grantor, Mrs. Ina Koss, a widow and
not remarried,

of the Village of Cahokia, County of St. Clair and State of Illinois, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), actual consideration in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the benefits resulting from the maintenance of the public highway, herein referred to, do by these presents, hereby grants, conveys and dedicates to the Village of Cahokia, for the purpose of a public highway, only the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

The Southerly five (5) feet of Lots No. 46 and 47 in Block No. 2 of
"GODIN'S SUBDIVISION OF PART OF LOT 213, SURVEYS 62, 63 and 64 COMMON-
FIELDS OF CAHOKIA, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS."

Situated in the County of St. Clair and State of Illinois, hereby releasing and waiving all right under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State.

And the Grantor further, as a part of this dedication, agrees to completely vacate the same within fifteen (15) days after notice in writing from the Village of Cahokia, St. Clair County, Illinois; and the Village of Cahokia, St. Clair County, Illinois, or any other state, county, township or district officials authorized by said Department and its or their representatives, engineers, agents, contractors and employees are hereby authorized to enter into and take full and complete possession of said tract for highway purposes only and the Grantee or any agency thereof will remove therefrom any obstruction at their own expense.

The Grantor, without limiting the interest above granted and conveyed, does hereby release the Grantee or any agency thereof forever, from any and all claim for damages sustained by the Grantor, his heirs, executors or assigns by reason of the opening, improving and using the above described premises for highway purposes only.
