The Southwestern Improvement Association, a Corporation of the State of Missouri, hereby present the accompanying Plat of the Town of Hillbom, being situated in and a part of the South West quarter of Sec. (25) Twp. Six, Range (25) S. W. Merit Range (15) Twp. East in the County of Mississippi and State of Missouri, to be filed in said County in accordance with the laws of the State. Said Association hereby dedicates to the exclusive use and benefit of the Sevier and St. Louis Railway, the tract on said Plat designated as its reservation consisting 100 ft. on each side of said Railway. Said Association further dedicates to the public use and benefit all streets and alleys on said Plat. Said Streets and Alleys being parallel with or at right angles with each other and with said Railway. The Alleys being Twenty ft. (20) wide and the Streets Sixty ft. (60) wide except Washington Avenue which is Eighty ft. (80) wide, unless otherwise indicated. The remainder of Town or plat is reserved to said Association for its use and sale in the tract or parcels by Lots and Blocks as therein indicated.

In Testimony Whereof, the Southwestern Improvement Association has caused this dedication and declaration to be signed by its President and Secretary this 5th day of January A. D. 1884.
