WARRANTED SYSTEM: The System consists of GenFlex brand membrane, GenFlex brand components including: insulation, fasteners, adhesives, sealants, flashings, fastener plates, metal bars, edge metal and related GenFlex brand accessory items used in accordance with GenFlex Roofing Systems published written technical specifications.

COVERAGE: GenFlex Roofing Systems, LLC ("GenFlex"), warrants to the building owner ("Owner") named below, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations set forth herein, that for the period in which this GenFlex Warranty is effective, GenFlex will repair any leak in the GenFlex Roofing System ("System") on Owner's Building at the address shown below caused by a defect in the GenFlex brand meterial, or workmanship within the scope of this warranty.

TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND LIMITATIONS

INSTALLER: Installation of the System must be by the Licensed GenFlex roofing contractor named below.

ROOF ACCESS: During the term of this warranty, GenFlex employees and/or designated representatives shall have free access to the roof for inspection, audit, or repair purposes during

ROOF MODIFICATION: Owner shall obtain GenFlex's written approval before making any alterations to the roof system or installing any structures, flutures, or utilities on or through the roof. This includes modification of the GenFlex roof system to serve as a support platform for Photovoltaic (PV) Arrays (aka – Solar Panels), Garden Roofs, Decks, Patios, and areas intended for public access. Roof modification approval typically requires owner sponsored enhancement of the roof system to meet additional performance requirements to ensure service life following the proposed modification. GenFlex is the sole judge of whether or not enhancements to the roof system are required. Failure to obtain GenFlex approval for a roof

If GenFlex's investigation of any claim under this warrantly reveals that GenFlex is not responsible under the terms of this warrantly for owner's claim, owner shall promptly reimburse GenFlex the investigation and repair costs incurred by

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the provisions of paragraph 6 and 7 shall remain in full force and effect.

TRANSFER: This warranty may not be transferred upon change of ownership of the building shown below unless the owner (a) notifies GenFlex in writing of its proposed change at least 45 days prior to the change; (b) pays GenFlex the current warranty transfer fee; and (c) completes all repairs required by GenFlex in order to correct failures to comply with Owner's

DISPUTE: Any daim or dispute between Owner and GenFlex arising out of this warranty or relating to any material supplied or specifically required by GenFlex shall be resolved by final and binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. MAINTENANCE & CARE REQUIREMENTS

We are pleased that you have selected a warranted GenFlex™ product for your building. Below are some helpful tips on how to safeguard your roofing investment and what to do in the event a warranty claim should ever need to be filed on this project:

RECOMMENDATIONS

A. REGULAR MAINTENANCE

- 1. The roof should be inspected by a licensed GenFlex Roofing Systems contractor at least twice a year (in the spring and fall) and after any severe storm. Maintenance procedures should be recorded as they are performed along with a log of all people accessing the roof.
- 2. All counter-flashing, metal work, equipment curb and supports, pitch pockets, caulking, grease guards, traps, secondary sheets, walk pads, and any other rooftop accessories functioning in conjunction with the membrane roofing system should be properly maintained at all times. If a secondary (sacrificial) sheet is used to protect an area around a stack or vent, it should be inspected and replaced if deterioration should occur. Walk pads are to be maintained by the building owner and are not covered by the GenFlex warranty.
- Ponded water (defined as water standing on the roof for more than forty-eight (48) hours) should not be allowed on the roof. Roofs should have slope to drain and all drain areas must remain clean in order to function properly. Remove all debris from the roof since debris on the roof surface may be swept into drains by rains.
- 4. Materials should not be stored on the roof. The building owner should remove broken bottles, metal, etc., and immediately report any damage or vandalism to GenFlex Roofing Systems. Contact GenFlex in writing for approval if additional equipment is to be installed, e.g. HVAC units, Antennas, Roof Top Camera, etc.
- Regular cleaning should be performed in areas where potentially harmful contaminates may accumulate, e.g., oil, grease, Freon, acids, solvents. Periodic cleaning of white or colored roof membranes may be needed to maintain the membrane's reflective properties and aesthetic appearance. Contact the GenFlex Technical Department for additional preventive maintenance. Note: Roof damage due to exposure to certain chemicals and/or contaminates is excluded from warranty
- 6. If there will be foot traffic on the roof for any reason, contact an approved GenFlex Roofing Systems contractor for the installation of protective walkways.

B. SHOULD YOU HAVE A LEAK:

- Contact GenFlex Roofing Systems at (800) 443-4272.
- 2. Determine the cause of the leak. It may be the result of a clogged drain, broken pipes, loose counter-flashing, broken skylights, open grills or vents. Failure to determine the cause may result in a service charge fee.
- Note conditions resulting in leakage. Heavy or light rain, wind direction, temperature, and time of day that the leak occurs are all important clues to tracing roof leaks. Note whether the leak stops shortly after each rain or continues to drip until the roof is dry. By being prepared with the facts, the diagnosis and repair of the leak can proceed more rapidly.
- All leaks must be reported to GenFlex Roofing Systems in writing within thirty (30) days.
- 5. If necessary, make temporary repairs with GenFlex edge caulk or a butyl base caulking. Never use roof cement or petroleum
- 6. Permanent repairs to the roofing system must be made by an approved GenFlex Roofing Systems contractor using GenFlex approved products.
- It is the owner's responsibility to provide access to the roofing membrane surface by removing or moving rooftop equipment, pavers, severely ponded water, snow or any materials that prevent complete investigation and repair of the roof system.

C. SHOULD YOU WANT TO MAKE ADDITIONS OR ALTERATIONS TO THE ROOF SYSTEM:

1. Contact GenFlex Roofing Systems in writing for approval before making alterations on, adjacent to, or through the roof system, or when changing the interior use of the building.

RECOMMENDATIONS

GenFlex supports and recommends following the guidelines for good roofing practices found in the Manual of Roof Inspection, Maintenance and Emergency Repair for Existing Single-Ply Roofing Systems published by the Single Ply Roofing Institute (SPRI).
