


RESTRICTIVE COVENANT HIGHLIGHTS

- Single family homes of a minimum size may be constructed (1800 sq. ft. on water and 1500 sq. ft. off water).
- No trailers, motor homes, tents or temporary structures may be used as a residence.
- The Architectural Review Committee must review and approve all building plans in advance, and construction must be completed within one year.
- Tree removal (over 6 inches in diameter) must be approved in order to maintain the community's natural setting.
- Cats, dogs and other indoor pets are allowed under control.
