If you have a lot of hay, little mineral & protein blocks these cattle will blossom by spring.

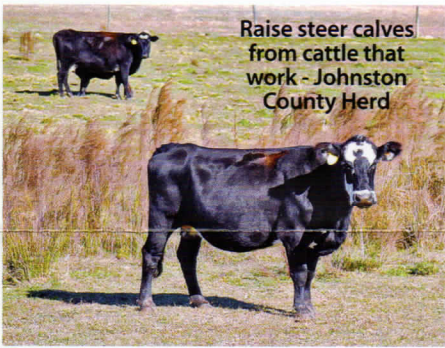
**Reg. 2-yr. old Angus bull,** sired by

 will be EID. All cattle will be on

 date week of sale

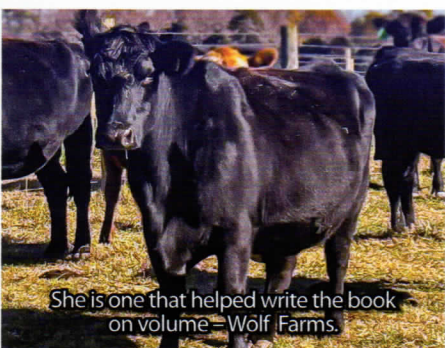

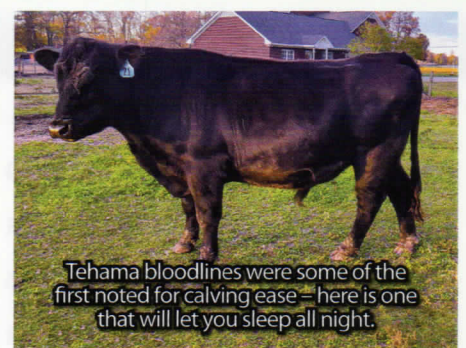
