AGREEMENT AS TO EASEMENT FOR ACCESS FOR FARMING PURPOSES

THAT Roscoe Haycock and Eileen Bailey Haycock, are the owners of the $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 22 North, Range 5 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Tazewell County, Illinois;

THAT Phyllis Tate, Ben Goeken and Frances Sheets, are the owners of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 5 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Tazewell County, Illinois;

THAT Roy E. Bailey is the owner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 5 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Tazewell County, Illinois;

THAT in order that certain of the various owners may have access to their respective tracts for performing farming operations, it is necessary that certain of these parties grant certain other of these parties a right of way or easement for access over and across a portion of their various tracts and therefore the parties in consideration of mutual benefits to accrue to all parties, have agreed among themselves as follows:






