

#### 2023 Farm Real Estate Value by State


**Dollars per Acre and Percent Change from 2022** 








### Land Values – Long Term














### Nebraska – 2024 Values Release

Statewide All-Land Average: \$4,015 per Acre (+5%)








## Commodity Prices... December 2024 Corn










# Commodity Prices... November 2024 Soybeans







## U.S. net farm income and net cash farm income, inflation adjusted, 2003–24F








### Where is the Crop Revenue Coming From?







What is the annual payment rate per acre you were offered to lease some of your farmland for the installation of a solar energy project to generate electricity?











#### Interest Rates – Federal Funds Rate




**Fed Funds Rate** (*Noun*) – the interest rate at which commercial banks borrow and lend their excess reserves overnight. This rate is set by the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC, "the Fed").

- Rate used to influence Monetary Policy... 12 Regional Fed Banks meet 8x annually.
- Directly affects consumer loans and credit cards.
- Currently 5.25%





### Interest Rates – 10 Year Treasury




- **10-Year Treasury** The 10-Year Treasury is the benchmark used to decide mortgage rates across the U.S. and is the most liquid and widely traded bond in the world.
  - Currently trading at or near highest level in 15 years, thereby making long-term commercial interest rates the highest we've seen in that time.






### Why Higher Rates?










### Foreign Farmland Ownership









## Farmer Attitudes Have Zig-Zagged...





Looking ahead to next year what are your biggest concerns for your farming operation?




### Farmland Price Expectations, 12 Months Ahead

### 2024 Land Price Expectations in Illinois








## **Longer Term Expectations**

#### Farmland Price Expectations, 5 Years From Now



- Less overall land coming on should support demand.
- May become "localized" issue.
