




- Open the App Store (for iOS devices) or Google Play Store (for Android devices) on your smartphone/tablet.
- In the search bar, type "BW Catalog" and press Enter.
- Look for the app with the name "BW Catalog" in the search results.
- Press the "Install" or "Download" button (the exact wording may vary depending on your device).
- Tap on the app icon to open "BW Catalog" and begin using it.
- That's it! You've successfully downloaded and installed the "BW Catalog" app on your smartphone/tablet.
- Open the "BW Catalog" app by tapping on its icon on your home screen
- When the app opens, you should see a login screen. Look for options like "Log In," "Sign In," or "Account."
- Tap on the "Log In" or "Sign In" button to proceed. Use only the account provided to you by Online Pros, this is the only account you can use to build your auction.



- -If you have multiple auctions running simultaneously, you should be able to view them within this home screen.
- all auctions must be initiated by the team member at Online Pros, because as a user, you will not have the capability to start an auction yourself. Instead, you would need to contact a member of the Online Pros team to initiate the auction on their platform.



# Adding Items to Your Auction



- Initiate Adding a Listing: Look for a button or icon that resembles a plus sign (+) on the bottom left of the screen. Tap on this plus sign to start adding a listing.

-You'll be presented with options to choose photos from your device's library/gallery or to take new photos using your device's camera.






- -Use your device's camera to capture photos of the item from various angles. This should include the front, back, sides, top, bottom, and any other relevant angles that showcase the item's features.
- Capture close-up shots that highlight specific details of the item, such as unique features, textures, or any signs of wear or damage.
- -Make sure the area where you're taking photos is well-lit to ensure clarity and accuracy. Natural light is often best for capturing details.
- -After taking each photo, review it to ensure clarity and visibility. Retake any photos that are blurry or unclear.
- Once you've captured all the necessary photos, you will have the option to rearrange their order or delete any that you don't want to include.











## Adding Item Details

- Once you are done adding photos, you will be prompted to provide details about the item you are selling. Details such as, descriptions, starting bids, and any other relevant information.

- Follow the prompts to input the necessary information for each item you wish to add to the auction.

- You can tap on your item to view its details or make any additional changes if needed.








## **Auctioning Vehicles**






- Open the BW Catalog app on your device.
- Click on the plus sign icon to initiate the process of adding a new item.
- You will be directed to a new screen to begin your new auction.





- Click or tap on the "VIN Lookup" button.
- A new screen will appear where you can input the VIN of the vehicle you want to list for auction.



- Enter the VIN number accurately into the designated field.
- Once the VIN is entered, the app will automatically retrieve and populate relevant vehicle information such as make, model, year, trim, mileage, and sometimes additional details.
- Double-check the populated information to ensure its accuracy. Pay close attention to details like the make, model, year, and trim to verify that they match the vehicle you're selling.










#### Details you should touch on

- -Is the vehicle running, if it's not running, specify the reason (e.g., needs a jump start, mechanical issue, or unknown).
- Engine Condition/Problems, Describe the current condition of the engine and any known or suspected issues. Detail any symptoms like strange noises, leaks, or performance issues.
- -Interior Condition, provide an overview of the interior condition, including the cleanliness and any visible wear or damage.
- Body Condition/Problems, assess and describe the exterior condition of the vehicle. Note any scratches, dents, rust spots, or other cosmetic issues.
- -Modifications or Issues, disclose any modifications that have been made to the vehicle, such as aftermarket parts or upgrades.

- A photo of the front of the unit A photo of the engine of the unit, buses both sides
- A photo of the interior dash A photo of the interior body
- A photo of the exterior back right A photo of the exterior front right
- A photo of the tires -A photo of the vin on the unit
