Currently, 62.5% of the 8,225 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.2%, renter occupied; and 16.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 7,927 housing units in the area - 66.6% owner occupied, 18.4% renter occupied, and 15.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.65%. Median home value in the area is \$128,028, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.03% annually to \$141,593.
