The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 59.2 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$44,548 in the area, compared to \$58,100 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$51,072 in five years, compared to \$65,727 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$60,565 in this area, compared to \$83,694 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$69,555 in five years, compared to \$96,109 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$23,779 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$31,950. The per capita income is projected to be \$27,039 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 54.7% of the 33,758 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.0%, renter occupied; and 12.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 32,699 housing units in the area - 56.5% owner occupied, 31.6% renter occupied, and 11.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.43%. Median home value in the area is \$146,738, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.50% annually to \$174,282.
