

Supplemental Arrowhead Property Details



There is a hidden Indian staircase (see cut out in ceiling planks near door on right side). The upper stairwell light fixture came from the Reynolds estate. There are solid brick walls on both sides of foyer.

Dining room mantle came from Reynolds estate. Den mantle is solid walnut from Thomasville chair company

Master bath has heated tile floors and functional spa tub

Central vacuum system throughout house

Downstairs floor is double layer heart pine

Interior doors show Moravian style hand stippling

Note hand pegged post and beam construction in upstairs closet doors

Basement was former kitchen with cooking fireplace

Outside globe lamppost came from downtown Forest City, NC

Gazebo has the steeple from Clemmons Methodist church

Barn/Workshop double doors open at both ends

“Doctors office” was built in mid 1800’s for Dr. Clingman

Onsite there are 2 wells with water available in outbuildings, barn/shop and shed/hanger still winterized. (400 ft each)

There are pecan, cherry, apples and pear trees in front yard area

Roof is metal and is approximately 6 years old

2 Heat pump systems that are within 10 years old (one services just master suite and one remainder of main level)

There are two window units upstairs and baseboard electric heat. No HVAC in 3rd level room
