Applications from qualified candidates are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. A candidate's scholarship merit, in addition to financial need, will be considered. Eligibility:

To be eligible for the school reimbursement: the applicant must be a VAA resident that is a graduate of an acceptable auction school that has recently obtained a Virginia Auctioneers License in the last two (2) years.

To be eligible for this designation scholarship: the applicant must be a VAA member for (1) full year, complete the application, and have met the requirements of the designation, and complete all the requirements in the last two (2) years.
